

EXPLANATION OF FEES

ACCEPTANCE OF OCCUPANCY AGREEMENT (Refundable)	EXPLANATION
General Deposit (\$ 875.00)	Refundable at the conclusion of the resident's contract on the proviso that all contractual obligations have been fulfilled and there are no outstanding charges. Outstanding charges may be deducted from the General Deposit.
Card Deposit (\$ 125.00)	Refundable upon a resident's final departure from Burgmann College on the proviso your card is returned. A \$200 charge is made for any replacement of card/door locks. Other additional charges may include Replace Swipe Card \$5.
ACCEPTANCE OF OCCUPANCY AGREEMENT (Non-Refundable)	EXPLANATION
Registration Fee (\$ 435.00)	A once only fee for new residents charged to defray the costs in the administration of new residents.
Burgmann Residents' Association (BRA) (\$ 230.00) TBC October 2025	An annual fee for Membership to the Burgmann Residents' Association. Payment of this fee is a condition of acceptance into membership of the College. The fee assists BRA's range of annual activities for its members.
ADDITIONAL FEES (Non-Refundable)	EXPLANATION
ANU Application Fee (\$ 140.00)	A once only fee for new residents charged by Burgmann College and returned to ANU once residents are in residence.
ANU Wifi Fee (\$ 458.00)	An annual fee to cover communication services at the College including data usage and access to the internet (Wi-Fi) and other related infrastructure.
Resident Building Levy (\$ 238.00)	An annual fee to assist with various resident experience capital refurbishments of the College buildings and grounds.
Capital Works Fee (\$ 227.00)	An annual fee to assist with the upkeep of the College's infrastructure across the Undergraduate and Village residences.
Unattributed Loss and Damage Recovery (ULDR) (\$ 82.00)	An annual fee to cover the cost of damage to, loss or recovery of, property within the College where such is beyond reasonable wear and tear and cannot be attributed to any individual or group. Half of any monies left in this fund at the end of the year are credited to BRA as an incentive to encourage residents to maintain the College environment.
